



## WHERE CAN I GET EMERGENCY FOOD IN GEELONG?

February 2021

There are many organisations that provide food assistance in the local Geelong region. Some however, have made changes to their services due to the restrictions and health and safety issues associated with the Covid-19 pandemic.

Below is current information regarding who, how, when and where food assistance is currently available across the Geelong region.

Due to changing conditions, restrictions and your health and safety we encourage you to call ahead before going out to access emergency food relief or to opt for contact-less delivery if available.

The Victorian State Government can provide emergency relief packages for vulnerable Victorians needing to self- quarantine due to Coronavirus (Covid-19).
